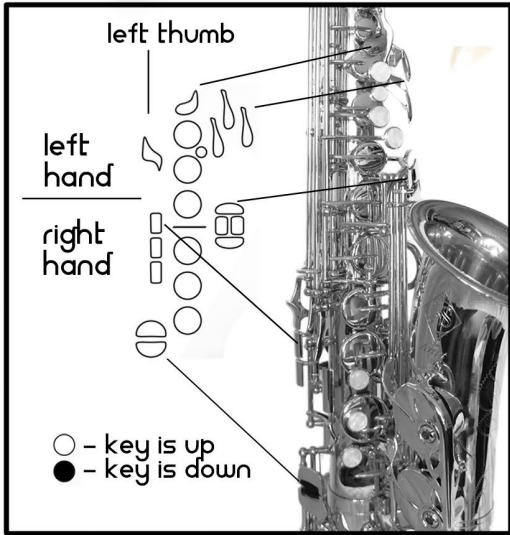

*Andante* walking pace  
*Largo* slowly  
*Rit.* gradually slower
